Position Overview & Tracks

This is not a traditional internship. Fellows work alongside founders, investors, and research leaders on real venture creation, ecosystem building, and cross-border innovation initiatives. We are hiring across three focused tracks. Indicate your track preference (one or more) in your cover letter.

Track A — Frontier AI Investment Fellow (Toronto)

- Source and screen early-stage AI4Science startups (self-driving labs, materials discovery, foundation models for science, AI4Bio)
- Prepare investment memos, competitive landscape maps, and technical due-diligence support
- Track funding activity and portfolio benchmarking across CAI's target verticals

Track B — Venture Partnerships Fellow (Toronto / Silicon Valley / Boston)



- Build and maintain a live pipeline of founders, funds, accelerators, and university tech-transfer offices across the Toronto–Silicon Valley–Boston corridor
- Represent CAI at demo days, pitch events, and ecosystem convenings (e.g. Acceleration Consortium, UofT, Waterloo, Stanford, MIT/Harvard networks)
- Support outreach, intro calls, and logistics for CAI roadshows (e.g. our August Silicon Valley trip) and manage CRM updates

Track C — Thought Leadership & Media Fellow (WeChat + LinkedIn)

- Manage the content calendar for 创世之力 (CAI's WeChat public account) under its two-tier institutional/observation content structure
- Produce bilingual (EN/CN) content on AI4S and AI4Bio insights, and support LinkedIn graphics and posting
- Support distribution of the CAI × Harvard HFTC white paper and forum recaps
